

## 4 WAY CHESS TOURNAMENT

- Date:** Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2019
- Venue:** St Michael & All Angels Church, The Drift, Martlesham Heath, Suffolk, IP5 3PL
- Event format:** Social friendly event to enjoy an unusual version of chess. You'll play as many games as you can get. When you finish one we will try to get you 3 other players for your next game.
- Time control:** No time control. No rush. Play at a reasonable speed to enjoy the game.
- Participants:** The number of participants is limited.
- Entry fee:** £10
- Prizes:** The overall winner is the one to play most number of games and score most number of wins! The prize fund will be subject to the number of entries
- Registration:** Registration starts at 12.30, finishes at 12.55
- Round times:** (Doors open at 12.30)  
The closing ceremony at 18.00
- Description:** '4 Way Chess' is a fun version of standard chess played on a special chessboard by four players. Normal chess rules apply except:
- The game is over and the winner is the one who checkmates any of the other 3 kings! Your pawns promote on your 8th rank!
  - Players take turns to make the moves in the clockwise direction.
  - It should be advised that there's no partnership between the 4 players, please! Everyone is playing for himself/herself not expecting help from others!
  - The decision of the arbiter is final.
  - Some more details about the game can be found on the internet. To note, some rules elsewhere might differ from the ones in this tournament!
