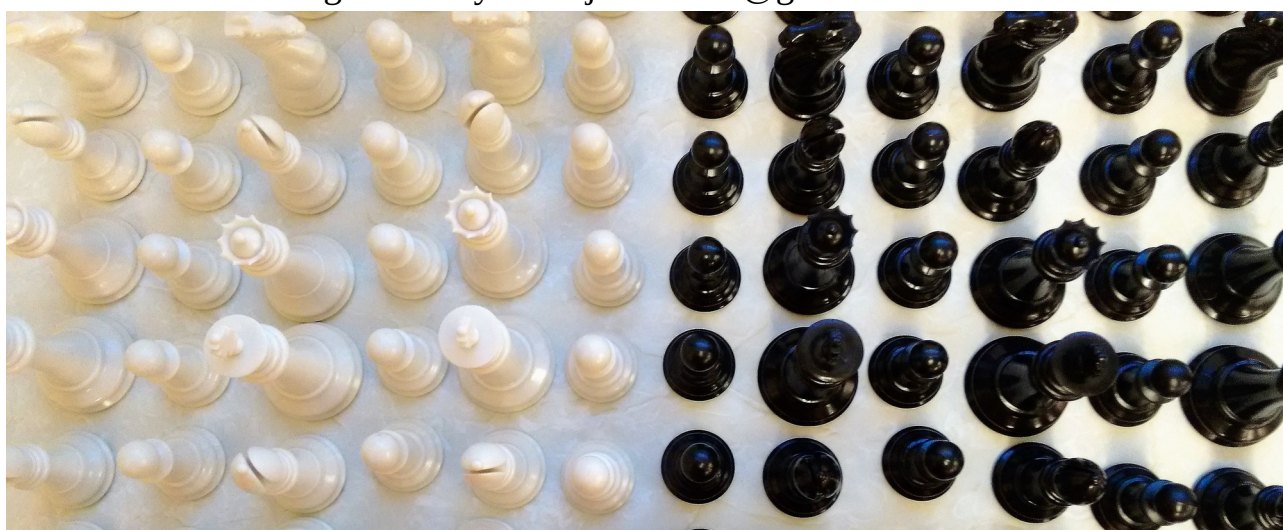


## PARENT + CHILD CHESS COACHING EVENT

### **RIGHT OF PARTICIPATION**

No age limits for Group 1.

Juniors no younger than 6 year-old in Group 2.

Basic knowledge of the chess rules is a bonus but not necessary. It's more important you have a will to learn.

Children are welcome to join a friendly chess-oriented group led by two young keen players.

- How the chess world works
- Strategy and tactics of chess game
- Being on the right path when starting one's chess career (culture, lifestyle, mindset, right tools in practising)

- Chess books/programs one can rely on
- Answers to your questions
